### *Republic of China*

#### **Workshop on Reduction of Greenhouse Gas Emissions, 3–7 November.**

► Objective: To discuss the latest trends and developments in greenhouse gas (GHG) emissions; identify solutions for the reduction of GHG emissions and available technologies; and examine policy instruments and prepare recommendations for the reduction of GHG emissions.

► Participants: Energy and environment professionals from industries, municipalities, and governments involved in GHG emission reduction-related activities.

#### **Training course on Food Safety Management for Seafood Processing and Marketing, 17–22 November.**

► Objective: To enhance participants' knowledge and skills in developing a seafood safety management plan; familiarize participants with different regulatory requirements; and formulate practical follow-up action plans for food safety management systems for seafood-processing SMEs.

► Participants: Managers/officers of seafood-processing companies, consultants of NPOs, trainers in governments and NGOs, and academics involved in the seafood-processing business.

### *India*

#### **Study meeting on the Development and Utilization of Biofertilizers for Promoting Sustainable Agriculture and Green Productivity, 5–11 November.**

► Objective: To review the current status of and recent developments in biofertilizer development and use; and analyze issues and challenges on the topics and formulate strategic recommendations to address them.

► Participants: Competent experts and professionals in the public or private sectors involved in the development, marketing, and utilization of biofertilizers.

### *Indonesia*

#### **Workshop on Strengthening the Management of Nonbank Financial Institutions Catering to Farmers and Rural-based Agribusiness, 17–21 November.**

► Objective: To examine the best management practices of successful non-bank financial institutions (NBFIs) and related organizations involved in rural microfinance; identify the critical human resources development needs of NBFIs and related organizations; and develop strategic plans to build and/or enhance their capabilities.

► Participants: Officers and managers of microlending organizations, agricultural insurance and credit guarantee companies, and agricultural and rural development banks; and senior officials in government organizations responsible for this field.

### *IR Iran*

#### **Training of Trainers in GP and Energy Efficiency, 15–19 November.**

► Objective: To develop a pool of trainers on energy efficiency; and prepare a training manual on energy management.

► Participants: Those who completed the e-learning course on energy efficiency.

### *Japan*

#### **Multicountry observational study mission on Waste Management in the Food-marketing and -processing Sectors, 4–11 November.**

► Objective: To review the status of waste management in the food-marketing and -processing sectors; learn about the modern technologies and practices adopted in these sectors; and observe the state-of-the-art technologies and practices of Japan.

► Participants: Middle- to top-level managers, officials, academics, or consultants of government, the private sector, or NGOs involved in waste management in the food-marketing and -processing sectors.
