DAMAGE to the land and environment stems from a combination of ignorance, bad planning and the selfish pursuit of short-term gains by some entrepreneurs.

Minister for Employment, Productivity and Industrial Relations Jioji Konrote said this while addressing a rural entrepreneurship training workshop in Nadi on Monday.

The meeting is facilitated by the Asian Productivity Organisation and the Fiji National University.

Mr Konrote said the Government was very much aware of this problem in Fiji.
