Objectives	The Green Productivity (GP) Mapping Dashboard aims to provide users with a comprehensive grasp of policies related to the environment, sustainability, GP, and the circular economy in APO members. Built to be easily updated to capture the latest policy details while archiving past details, the GP Mapping Dashboard also aims to serve as an archival tool enabling researchers to study trends in sustainability policy formulation.
Rationale	This web-based tool will serve policymakers, researchers, businesses, GP specialists, and the general public by providing an easy-to-navigate visualization of key environmental policies across different countries.
Background	In response to the accelerating need to address climate change in the past decade, governments around the world have put forward net-zero emission targets and national environmental strategies. These policies vary significantly in scope and implementation, even within the Asia-Pacific region and among APO members. The policies also undergo frequent updates and adjustments, which pose challenges for researchers, businesses, and the general public to understand and navigate the latest ones. The GP Mapping Dashboard aims to fill this gap by creating an interactive dashboard to provide users with a comprehensive grasp of environmental policies.
Topics	GP-related policies in APO members; Key elements of current sustainability efforts for economic growth; Net-zero emission policies and programs; Green growth policies and programs; Development plans and agendas for green growth and sustainable development; and a digital platform mapping out the policies and programs of each APO member economy.
