Remarks	This PIP supersedes the version issued on 9 December 2025 (Reference No. 749) to update the project title, timing, objectives, rationale, and background due to the unforeseen withdrawal of a participating company, Ngai Cau Building and Commercial Investment Joint Stock Company, and its replacement by Bach Mai Hospital requested by the Commission for Standards, Metrology and Quality, Vietnam.

Objectives	Establish demonstration companies on implementing environmental, social, and governance (ESG) measures for sustainable productivity in Vietnam; showcase the benefits of ESG principles and practices to private and public organizations; and create benchmarks and replicable case studies for adoption by other APO members.
Rationale	ESG has emerged globally as a key driver of sustainable development, guiding organizations toward responsible growth, transparency, and resilience. As regulatory expectations and stakeholder scrutiny intensify, embedding material ESG considerations into core operations helps organizations manage risk, maintain market access, and demonstrate accountability.
Background	<p>ESG principles are increasingly shaping how organizations operate and create long-term value. In Vietnam, national policies such as the green growth strategy and net-zero commitment, together with rising expectations from regulators, investors, and communities, are driving organizations to strengthen environmental management, social responsibility, and governance practices.</p> <p>Manufacturing enterprises and public institutions such as state hospitals are significant consumers of energy, water, and other resources, positioning them as key contributors to environmental sustainability. They are facing growing pressure to align with ESG standards due to evolving global supply chain requirements and national green transition commitments. Despite these drivers, ESG integration and reporting practices remain limited across sectors.</p> <p>This DMP project addresses these gaps by strengthening ESG capabilities, supporting practical implementation and standard reporting, and developing role models for wider replication.</p>
Topics	ESG principles, global trends, and business relevance; ESG international disclosure frameworks and practices; Development of ESG strategy and performance indicators; and Consultation on ESG implementation and reporting.
Outcome	Improved ESG capabilities of participating organizations, publication of ESG reports aligned with international standards, enhanced organizational sustainability and transparency, and replicable models for broader adoption across sectors in Vietnam and other APO members.
